Game Notes...The Bisons had a well balanced attack in last night's win over Maintenance at Ebersol Field...Al Miller led the 24-hit parade with a 4 hit night while Matt Norian, James Arredondo, John Roche and Paulo DaCosta all had 3 hits apiece...9 out of the 12 Bisons in the lineup had at least 1 RBI....new Bison Paulo DaCosta, who was tearing up the Southern League while toiling in Chattanooga, had another fine night at the plate going 3 for 4 with 4 RBI and his second homer of the year...DaCosta will not be returning to Chattanooga....super sub Matt Norian injured his hamstring while diving for a ball in right center field early in last night's game but like a true wounded Bison, Matt stayed in the game after moving to second base...Mike Roberts became the 4th Renegade this season to reach the 20 RBI mark with his 2 RBI last night...The Natural regained his power stroke lining a double and triple to deep right center and, gearing up for another post season run, showcased his side arm fosh ball in the later innings much to the chagrin of Paul Lamarre who spent the last couple of innings barking at the legend from deep left center...not relenting, the chatty Lamarre continued to chastise The Nat at Sweetwater later in the night...speaking of Sweetwater, 5 Bisons, known as "Scrambled Egg Head" entered a trivia contest at the Water...the team did not fare well...James Disco Turnbull had a single in his only at bat before fleeing Ebersol to catch the Sox at Fenway...Mike Clements may have set his all time record by arriving at Ebersol 15 minutes before game time...with his 4 hits, The Nat became the 6th Bison to reach the 20-hit mark in 2012...12 Bisons appeared in last night's game, the most of any game thus far this season...first place could be on the line when the Renegades close out their 2012 regular season next Tuesday night at Ebersol against the Dark Horses

- The Bisons with a team BA of .603 have a chance to become just the 4th Renegade team since 1998 to finish with a team BA of .600 or higher
- James Arredondo, Paul Lamarre and Mike Roberts all have a chance to reach 20/20/20 in Hits, RBI and RS....Arredondo and Lamarre need just 1 run scored while Mike Roberts needs to cross the plate 3 times in the Bison finale next Tuesday. It has been accomplished just 8 times since 1998 by six different players. John Roche in 2009, 2007 and 2004, John Megan in 2007, Keith Beaudin in 2006, Vin Digilio in 2004, Chris White in 2004 and Mike Norian in 1999. When Mike Norian accomplished the feat in 1999 he became the only Bison to complete a 30/30/30 when he finished that season with 39 hits, 31 RBI and 32 RS
- With his 3rd win of the season, Al Miller is now just 3 wins shy of 50 for his Renegade career
